


sex, gender identity (including gender expression), sexual orientation, disability, age, marrial status, income derived from a public assistance program, political beliefs, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity, in any program or incident. Persons with disabilities who require alternative means of communication for program information (e.g., Braille, large print, audiotape, American Sign Language, etc.) should contact the responsible Agency or USDA's TARGET Center at (202) 720-2600 (voice and TIY) or contact USDA through the Federal Relay Service at (800) 877-8339. Additionally, program information may be made available in languages other than English. To file a program discrimination complaint, complete the USDA and provide in the letter all of the information requested in the form. To request a copy of the complaint form, call (866) 632-9992.
