

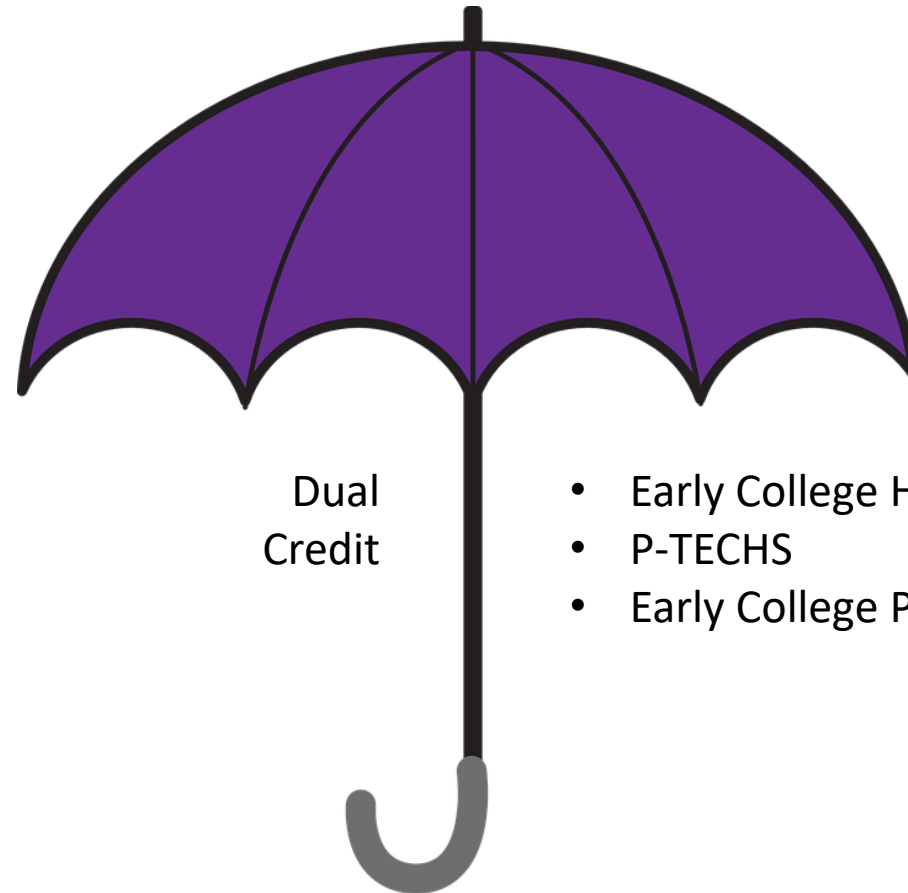

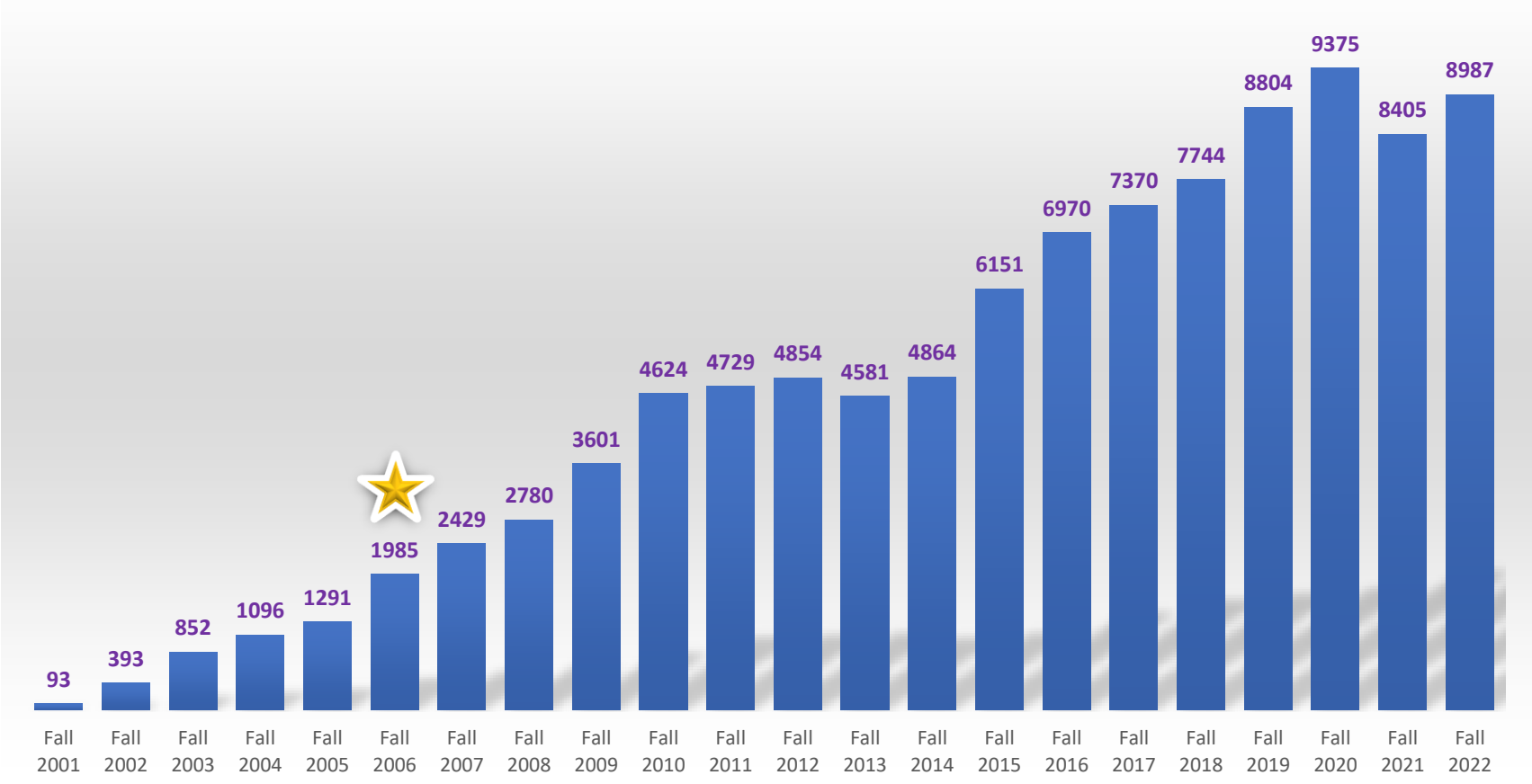

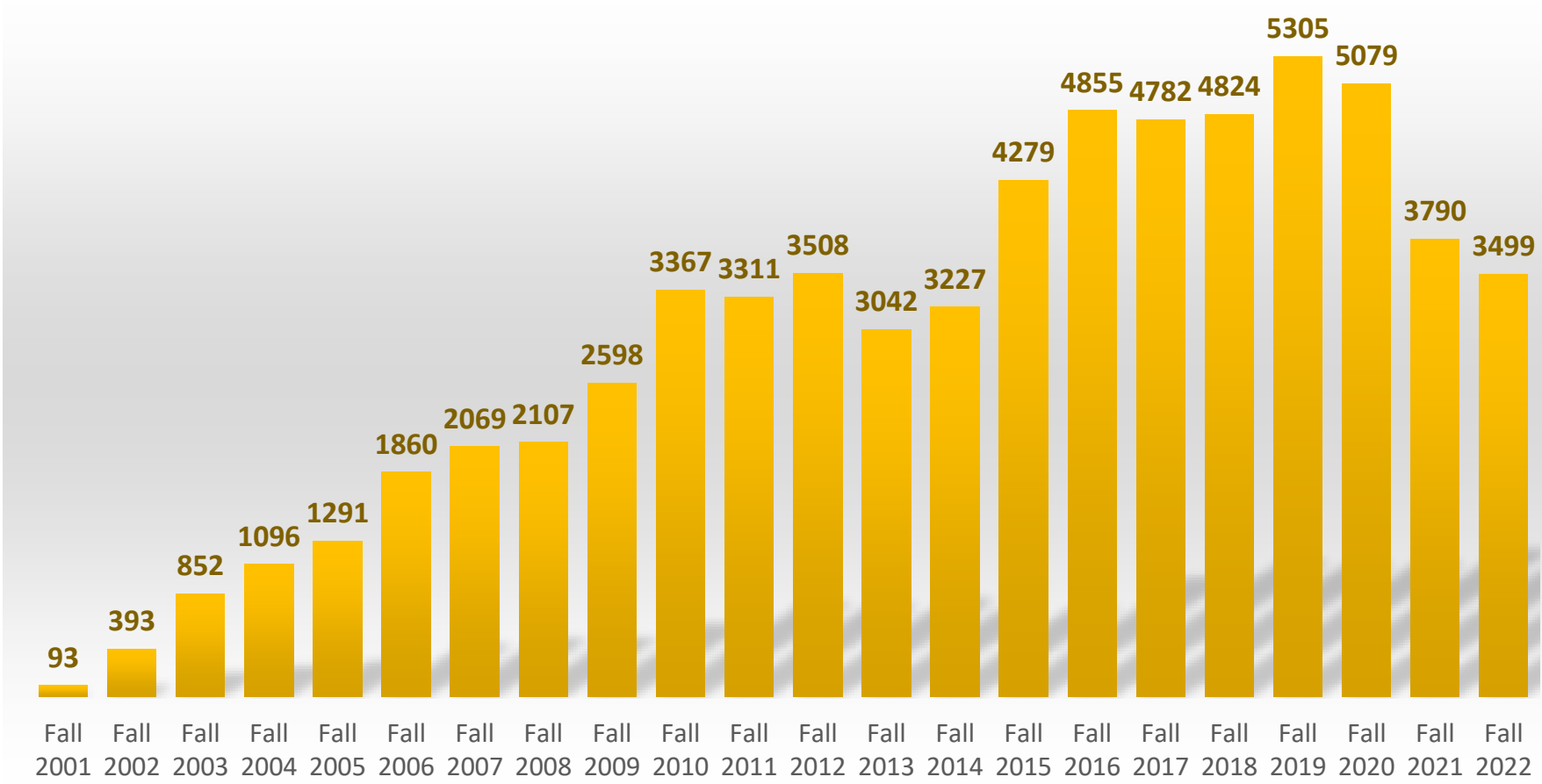


High School Enrollment





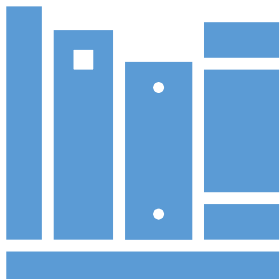
Dual Credit Enrollment Decline

Dual Credit Success

- Since 2001, **230** DC students have earned a post-secondary credential while in high school.
- **194** from Cathedral HS
- Dual Credit students have a higher GPA **3.7** vs 2.7
- Complete their courses at a higher rate **87%** vs 72%
- Earn an average of **13 college credits**



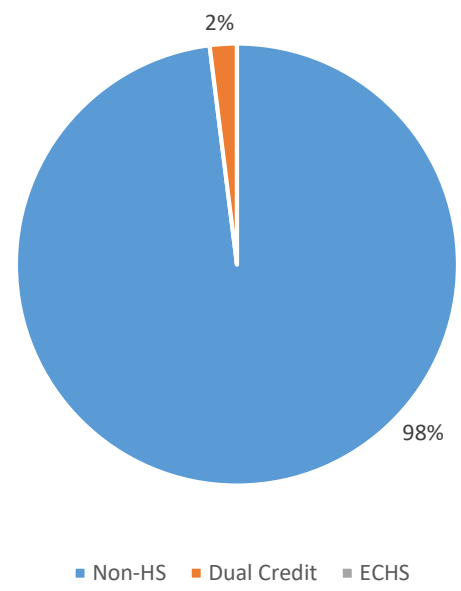
ECHS and P-TECHS?

- Both College and Career Readiness School Models (CCRSM) target students underrepresented in higher education, particularly those “at risk of dropping out of school and who might not otherwise go to college.”
- **ECHS** – students choose their major. The goal is to earn an associate degree (AA, AS, or AAT) before high school graduation.
- **P-TECHS** – students choose a P-TECH in an area they are already interested in. The goal is to earn a post-secondary certificate, an associate degree or an industry certification. P-TECHS must include a business and industry partner.

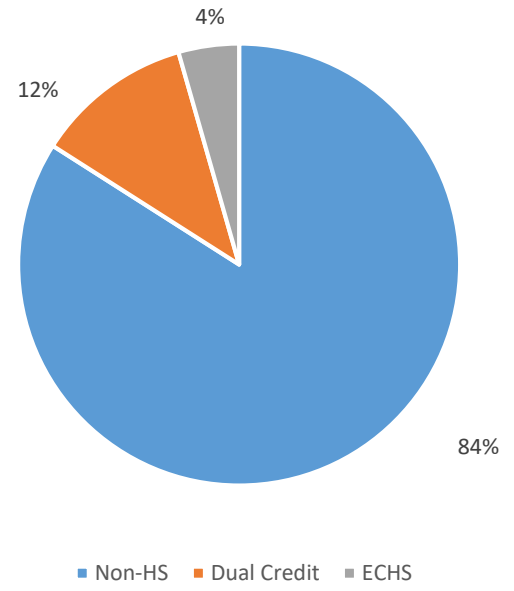


Enrollment Comparisons

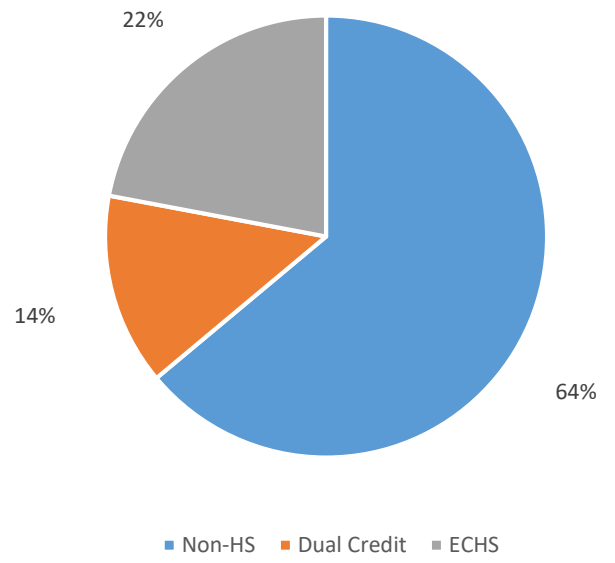
Fall 2002

ECHS Success

- Since 2009*, **5,894** students have earned a post-secondary credential while in high school.
- **65.38%** of our students earn a post-secondary credential while in high school.
- Former ECHS students have an EPCC graduation rate **twice** as high than Dual Credit students and **four times** higher than those who did not take college courses while in high school.
- Those who transfer to UTEP are **three times** more likely to graduate from the university in four years, have a **higher GPA**, and have higher rates of matriculation to **graduate school**.
- By 2024, we will have **18 ECHS** and **21 P-TECHS** partnering with these **8 districts**...
