

Frequently Asked Questions

Attendance:

For truancy, are the 10 unexcused absences divided into A&B days?

The 10 unexcused absences are by period, not days. IF a student accrues ten or more unexcused absences in a 6-month period, a truancy court referral will be submitted to the District Attorney's Office.

Transportation:

Is there any way to shorten bus routes or add another bus route?

Northwest Early College has traditionally only had two buses because of the number of enrolled students. It may take up to 90 minutes for a bus to run its entire route. Parents are able to pick up or drop off students at campus. Staff generally begins to arrive at 7:00 am, at which time the grotto is opened, for parents to drop off students.

Community Service:

How do I know when community service is available?

Community Service opportunities come up throughout the year. Most clubs to at least one community service event a year and the campus sets up various community service events as they are available. Students in EDUC 1300 are required to do community service as part of the course. The instructor for this class will provide some options. Students are encourage to perform community service through their church, local organizations and charities.

When is the TSI offered?

The TSI is offered about every month. Teachers use various data points to determine when students are ready to test. There is no fee for testing on campus and we provide plenty of opportunities to test. Students are prepped for the TSI through their English and/or Math classes.

Supervision:

Who supervises students in the Grotto in the mornings?

Like most High Schools, the cafeteria is the common space for students. In the morning, an administrator may not be present but there are adults in the cafeteria or close by. The cafeteria has several cameras that are view by district police during the day.
